- Advocate for human rights and a robust and urgent humanitarian response,
- Choose to walk in prayerful solidarity with the people of Gaza, the Israeli hostages, and all
  victims of unjust violence. Consider the invitation from Canadian Churches for a Just Peace,
  the Gaza Ceasefire Pilgrimage coordinated by <u>KAIROS</u>.
- Examine and study the resources of the Council's peace research institute, <a href="Project Ploughshares">Project Ploughshares</a>,
- Donate to a reputable humanitarian charity that is responding to the crisis, such as <u>ACT</u>
   <u>Canada</u> members, <u>Mennonite Central Committee</u>, and <u>Development and Peace Caritas</u>
   Canada,
- Speak up and stand against discrimination based on religious identity wherever it appears,
- Join with other religious communities in interfaith and multifaith dialogue that listens to one another's experiences, acknowledges one another's hopes and traumas, and steps boldly toward a lasting peace with justice.
